Part Time Staff Job Description

Position Description

Maintain an effective Scouting Program in targeted Community Centers & Community Chartered Partners by providing leadership to youth programming utilizing the traditional Scouting programs of Cub Scouts (5 to 10 yrs. old), Boy Scouts (Boys 11 to 17 yrs. old), Venturing (Coed 14 to 20 yrs. old).

Success is measured by:

- Weekly youth participation, program delivery, and rank advancement.
- Weekly volunteer engagement.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Complete Youth Protection Training, Fast Start, and Basic Training programs for the Cub, Boy Scout, Venturing programs.
- Review and prepare weekly program plans so that programs are developed and executed for Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Venturing age youth.
- Under the direction of your Staff Leader, carry out weekly Cub Scout, Boy Scout, and Venturing programs at designated community centers and schools.
- Encouraged to do at least quarterly field trips or outings for each Scouting program, and inform youth of summer camp and day camp opportunities.
- Implement program so as to ensure that every youth participant will earn rank advancement during the program year.
- Work as the link to traditional scouting programs in the local area and share information on how and where youth can join these groups.
- Meet weekly with Staff Leader to review progress and for supplemental training.
- Potentially assist with fall recruitment in selected schools.
- You will be provided one Scout Uniform and be expected to wear it at all meetings with youth.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 21 years old and a United States citizen
- Reliable transportation required
- Willing to work with youth (Background in youth and/or youth development is desired.)
- Successful completion of Criminal Background Check required and adult registration with the BSA
- Adhere to the Scout Oath and Law

Compensation:

- \$15 hourly with an expectation to have weekly meetings at assigned community centers with a maximum of 10 hours a week. (This will include outings and field trips)
