



# WILDERNESS REMOTE FIRST AID & CPR



**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course is designed to provide urgent assessment and treatment of injuries that may occur when immediate help is unable to respond quickly. The course is taught by American Red Cross certified instructors.

## COURSE TIMELINE FOR ALL COURSES (All times below are local according to the course location)

In order to be certified in *Wilderness and Remote First Aid* you must have a current CPR/AED certification. If you have a current certification, you may skip the Friday session and start your course on Saturday morning. Be sure to bring a copy of your current/valid certification card with you. If not, please make plans to attend Friday. Everyone must attend both the Saturday and Sunday sessions to complete the certification.

FRIDAY: 6:30 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. (CPR/AED CLASS)  
 SATURDAY: 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.  
 SUNDAY: 8:00 A.M. to noon.

**COST:** Wilderness and Remote First Aid is \$35 and for CPR is \$20. These costs include course material only.

**You will need to bring and prepare your own meals. Camping is available, but not required.**

**REGISTRATION:** Due to high demand there is a 4 person limit per Unit. Exceptions will be made if the course does not reach capacity. A waiting list will be maintained for each course. The registration deadline is Friday, seven (7) days prior to each course. **PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.**
