WHAT IS RESIDENT CAMP?

Cub Scout and Webelos Scout Resident Camps are a council-organized, theme oriented, overnight camping program. Cub Resident Camp is an exciting three days and two nights just for Cubs. Webelos Summer Camp is a fun-filled four days and three nights that are just for our Webelos Scouts.

Cub Scout Resident Camp is designed to blend advancement and fun, packed into an adventure filled weekend. Additionally, the Scouts will experience the outdoors and encounter life lessons including responsibility and cooperation.

New this year, siblings will be able to participate during our Family Resident Camp. Cub Scout aged siblings may join the fun, and the program will consist of Tiger through Bear appropriate activities and advancements.

WHO CAN ATTEND RESIDENT CAMP?

Cub Scouts entering into 1st-3rd grade in fall of 2017 can attend Cub Resident Camp with their parent.

Cub Scouts entering the 1st-3rd grades and siblings (including Webelos aged Scouts) K-5th can attend Family Resident Camp. (No Webelos programing will be offered.)

Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts who are going into 4th or 5th grade in fall of 2017 can attend Webelos Resident Camp as den or individual(s) with their parent(s).

** No Pets are allowed at any of our Resident Camp sites at any time during the week. **

WHEN AND WHERE IS CUB SCOUT AND WEBELOS RESIDENT CAMP?

This year we are offering 3 sessions of Webelos, 1 session of Cub Resident Camp, and 1 session of Family Resident Camp. See the back of this page for exact dates and locations. Scouts and units can attend any camp that they choose. They can also attend more than one camp.

WHAT ABOUT LEADERSHIP?

If attending together, Scouts are encouraged to register as a pack/den. Webelos Resident Camp requires two deep leadership and a 1:4 ratio adults to Scouts from your pack. Leaders must be registered in the BSA in order to attend camp. Cub Resident Camp requires a parent or guardian to attend with your Scout.

WHAT TO BRING?

Personal camping gear and tents are needed. Bring rain gear if weather looks threatening, sunscreen and bug repellent. See a more detailed “what to bring” list in the Camp Leader’s Guide which can be found on our web site www.lhcbsa.org. **No open-toed shoes or sandals are allowed at Camp.**

WHAT ABOUT YOUNGER CHILDREN?

Webelos Resident Camps are for registered Scouts only. Siblings cannot attend Webelos Resident Camp. Siblings can attend the Family Resident Camp session for the extra scout fee.

CAMPERSHIPS

A limited number of camperships are available for those who may need help with the fee. The youth’s parents must submit the application for a campership by April 28th. Contact the Scout office at (502) 361-2624 for more information.

HOW MUCH DOES RESIDENT CAMP COST?



Cub Scouts can attend Resident Camp for \$135.00. This fee includes Cub and Adult registration as well as a t-shirt, patch and all the fun possible. **Register by May 5th and receive a \$20 discount (Discounted fee \$115).** Extra Scout/Sibling Fee is \$80 and an Extra Leader/parent is \$50. Patches will be available for adults.

Webelos Scouts can attend Resident Camp for \$165.00. This fee includes a t-shirt, patch and all the fun possible. **Register by May 5th and receive a \$20 discount (Discounted fee \$145).** Units get one free adult for every 6 youth that attend from your pack. The additional adult fee for camp is \$70. Patches will be available for adults.

SECOND TRIP DISCOUNT!!!

We want all our Scouts to have an opportunity to come to camp! This year we are offering a discount for families who have both a Cub Scout and a Webelos Scout! Families who attend Webelos Resident Camp, can earn a \$20 discount off the Cub and Adult registration fee when they come back and attend with their Cub Scout.
