

Camp Crooked Creek Merit Badge Pre Requisites

What is a pre-requisite?

A pre-requisite is a merit badge requirement that cannot be completed at camp or is a condition needed to participate in the merit badge or program. Scouts need prerequisites signed off under the supervision of a Council-approved Merit Badge Counselor. Partial awards will be issued at camp unless the scout provides evidence of completion. Scouts can complete the requirements after camp but must work with an approved Merit Badge Counselor.

A pre-requisite can also be an age or weight restriction imposed by the camp based on experiences related to specific badges. For example, for Shotgun Shooting Merit Badge, we recommend Scouts weigh at least 100 lbs. because of the firearms used. Check the Leader's Guide for more descriptions.
