## Pfeffer Scout Reservation Merit Badge Pre-Requisites

## What is a pre-requisite?

A pre-requisite is a merit badge requirement that in most cases cannot be completed at camp or is a special condition needed to participate in that merit badge or program. In order for a Scout to be eligible for completion of the badge, these requirements would need to be signed off under the supervision of a Council-approved Merit Badge Counselor before camp. Partials will be issued at camp unless evidence of completion is provided. Scouts can complete the necessary requirements after camp if desired but must work with an approved Merit Badge Counselor.

A pre-requisite can also be an age or weight restriction imposed by the camp based on experiences related to certain badges. For example, we recommend Scouts who take Shotgun Shooting weigh at least 100 lbs. because of the firearms used. Check the Leader's Guide for more descriptions.
