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- School Assignments/Scheduling/Buzz Ups/Organization (Slide 11) (5 mins)
 - This is your chance to discuss the importance of us being on the same page in terms of the scheduling, and plan regarding promotion (buzz ups, flyers, open houses, etc.)
 - Executives will be contacting school (unless help is warranted and requested) to set up buzz up and sign up night.
 - Reiterate that the most successful recruitments have a buzz up & SIGN UP AT THE SCHOOL or AT EACH SCHOOL ASSIGNED.
 - If more than one school is assigned, we must do a recruitment at each school for maximum results. Utilize parent orientation (1st meeting after recruitment) to further orient and organize dens and leadership.

 SET THE STAGE PRIOR TO RECRUITING ADULTS SHOW EXAMPLE VIDEO Adult Leader Recruitment "Yardstick" Approach
 - If needed reiterate any "Helpful Tips for Recruiting Leaders" (Page 12)
- "Pack Orientation"/first Meeting (Slide 13) (Page 13) (3 mins)
- Fees/Registration/Paperwork (Slide 14) (3 mins)
 - Brief discussion on fees:
 - \circ Youth = \$85 for registration & \$16 for insurance = \$101 for 12 months
 - It is a best practice approach to only collect this at the sign-up night and discuss Pack dues (if applicable) and collect Pack dues at an upcoming meeting.
 - Additional best practice is to have a Popcorn Goal in the fall for new families to sell and achieve to where there Dues are covered and even their registration for the following year (2025).
 - Adults = 65 for registration & 16 for insurance = 81 for 12 months
 - Best practice approach is for Packs to budget for and fundraise to pay for adult leader registrations.
