Learn the skills necessary to put the “Outing in Scouting!” This is your opportunity to learn how to conduct a great BALOO Outdoor Program. The outdoor training includes sessions on how to camp within the guidelines set forth by BSA and the Guide to Safe Scouting, hands-on sessions for many of the outdoor group activity badges and camping skills for the novice and experienced camper alike. For a Pack to camp, the Pack must have at least one registered leader over the age of 21 who has completed BALOO training in camp at all times. This training is for any adult Scout leader who wants to help his/her Pack expand their activities in the outdoor experience. Take your Pack’s performance to the next level! Get ready for Scouts!

**Course start times may vary.** Your Course Director will send information regarding your course via email.

You must be a registered Scout leader and complete the BALOO online modules at [my.scouting.org](http://my.scouting.org) before attending this training. **Also, bring a copy of the Annual Health and Medical Record Form with Parts A & B filled out completely (Part C (Physical) not required for this training.)** This form can be obtained through <https://lhcbbsa.org/forms/>

**Equipment and Materials List for Outdoor Training:** Camp/Lawn Chair, Cup, Tent, Ground Cloth, Sleeping Bag, Flashlight and Lantern, Weather Appropriate Clothing, Personal Items, Garbage Bags and bring other camping items that you feel are necessary for your comfort. We ask that you be in uniform for this training.

**Cost \$30: Meals provided include:** Friday night-Cracker Barrel (snack), Saturday-Breakfast and Lunch. For the training at Tunnel Mill Scout Reservation, your vehicle is to be parked by the Dining Hall. For information or questions, contact the Scout Service Center at (502) 361-2624. **Cut off dates for Registration** will be set for 3 business days prior to training.

**No walk-ins:** unless arrangements made prior with contacts for training or above.

Council/District Refund Policy

A refund will be made to an individual or group that cancels program attendance/registration, less a 15% administrative charge as long as a written request is made at least 30 days prior to a council or district program/activity.

No refunds will be given to an individual or group that cancels program attendance/registration within 30 days of a scheduled council or district program/activity. Exceptions for medical situations or family emergencies can be made, but must be submitted in writing within 7 days after the program/activity.

No refund request will be accepted after 7 days of the activity.

Fees are transferable to other Scouts but not refundable. All requests for refunds must be submitted in writing with a copy of the receipt or cancelled check.

A separate refund policy applies to all national high adventure trips and national jamborees. See the national high adventure or jamboree packets for a detailed policy.
