

## **Scouting for food COVID Protocol for Units:**

### **Flyer distribution:**

- Scouts/family groups will be limited to 2-3 Scouts with 2 adults per vehicle for flyer distribution. It is preferred and encouraged to be one family going together.
- The entire group is only together to pick up flyers. There will be no big gathering to pick up flyers or to “map and go”.
- There will be no big gathering at the end. Once you have completed your map/flyers, you can go home. Text or call the person in charge of your unit to let them know you are finished and ask if there is more to be done.
- Note that everyone will be required to socially distance (6 ft. apart) and wear a mask.
- Scouts/families will be asked to conduct a health check before arriving at the meet up location.
- No lunch is provided. Scouts will bring their own (if needed).
- It is recommended that Scouts use hand sanitizer often and wash hands where available.

### **Food Collection day:**

- Group sizes for food collection will be limited 2-3 Scouts with 2 adults per vehicle. It is preferred and encouraged to be one family going together.
- Ideally, the same groups will go back out and pick up the food where they left flyers.
  - If this doesn't happen, Scouts will gather to get maps of where the flyers were left.
- No group gatherings.
- To limit contact on the containers, food will not be sorted by Scouts. We will deliver to the food banks and they will sort the items.
- Once Scouts have completed the first map, call in to see if more food needs to be collected. Contact via cell phone allows for units to send pictures of maps or areas that still have food to collect.
- No lunch is provided. Scouts will bring their own (if needed).
- It is recommended that Scouts use hand sanitizer often and wash hands where available.
- It is required that all those involved to use social distancing guidelines (6 ft. apart) and to wear a mask.
- Scouts/families will be asked to conduct a health check before arriving at the meet up location.

### **UNIT LEADER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Conduct health reviews of youth and adults prior to the start of flyer distribution and again at food collection.

-Remind families/Scouts that they must wear a mask and be 6 ft. apart.

-Remind families/Scouts that they must bring hand sanitizer and use it often and wash hands (where possible).
