

COVID-19 Council Procedures and Guidelines For the Council Camps

Council Camps

Specific documents outlining procedures for the use of the camps by Scouting groups and families are sent to group leaders prior to scheduled outings. This includes a “Welcome to camp” letter which covers procedures and protocols, a “Restart Scouting” checklist and a “COVID prescreening form” which must be submitted by each participant when arriving at the camp. Units are asked to follow State and CDC recommendations for group size. Approval by the unit’s chartered partner is required. Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance to allow for proper follow up.

Beginning November 20 and continuing until further notice, the following procedures will be in place.

Group outings should be restricted to smaller groups of 8-10 to allow for social distancing and to reduce exposure. Day visits only are strongly recommended. If camping, Adirondacks or tents only may be used.

Indoor camping facilities will not be available. Day only indoor activities will require prior approval by the Properties Manager, Brian Weigel to confirm group sizes and facilities. Call (502) 400-5361 or email brian.weigel@scouting.org
