Camp Crooked Creek Merit Badge Prerequisites

What is a prerequisite?

A prerequisite is a merit badge requirement that, in most cases, cannot be completed at camp or is a particular condition needed to participate (weight, age, height) in that merit badge or program. For a Scout to be eligible for completion of the badge, these requirements would need to be signed off under the supervision of a Council-approved Merit Badge Counselor before camp. Partials will be issued at camp unless evidence of completion is provided. Scouts can complete the requirements after camp if desired but must work with a Merit Badge Counselor. Check the Leader's Guide for more descriptions.
