Campmaster Application

What is a Campmaster? A group of selected, trained, and registered Scouters who serve at council weekend camps whenever troops, teams, Webelos dens, or other groups are using any part of a camp property. Duties include checking Scout units in and out of camp, reviewing rules and regulations with campers, and recording attendance. Campmasters choose the weekends during which they will serve at selection meetings held twice a year at one of the camps, at the council office, or via an online meeting.

To participate as a Campmaster, you must attend a training session with a council representative or the volunteer Campmaster Chair.
