What is a “Campmaster”: Campmasters are a group of selected, trained, and registered Scouters who serve at council weekend camps whenever troops, teams, Webelos dens, or posts are using any part of the camp property. Duties include checking in and checking out units as well as reviewing rules and regulations and recording attendance. Campmasters select their own time and frequency of service, but they usually serve two to four times a year.
