WHAT IS Cub Scout Summer Experience?

Cub Scout Summer Experience is a great summer activity for Cub Scouts. It is a 3-day experience where Cub Scouts can shoot BB guns, bows and arrows, learn about nature, do leatherwork and crafts, play games, sing songs, and do many more activities. Leaders and Scouts alike have a great time.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

All registered Cub Scouts going into the 1st thru 5th grades in fall of 2021.

WHEN AND WHERE CAMP?

15 Day Camps will be conducted in June and July throughout the 64 counties in the Lincoln Heritage Council. Scouts and units can attend any camp that they choose. They can also attend more than one day camp.

HOW MUCH DOES CUB SCOUT SUMMER EXPERIENCE COST?

\$75, this fee includes a t-shirt, cup, patch, snacks, crafts, and all the fun possible. Register by May 2(June camps) June 4 (July camps) and receive a \$10 discount (Discount fee \$75 or \$100). *(A late fee of \$20 will be charged for all applications received within 3 weeks of the start of camp.)

PATCH IS FREE

Sign up by completing the applications that follow and paying the appropriate fees. Return this form with payment to the council office.

*ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE IN NO LATER THAN 3 WEEKS BEFORE CAMP STARTS!

A LATE FEE OF \$20 WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED WITHIN 3 WEEKS OF YOUR CAMP STARTING.

WHAT ABOUT LEADERSHIP?

Scouts should register with their pack.

Five-day adults whose application is received two weeks before camp starts will receive a free t-shirt. Pack Leadership & parents are encouraged to participate. All Tiger Cubs (1st Grade) must be accompanied by an adult. Packs may be required to provide adult leadership and will be notified if necessary. **No adults pay a fee.**

WHAT TO BRING?

Cub Scouts should bring a sack lunch each day; bring non-perishable foods & drinks only. Bring rain gear if weather looks threatening, sunscreen and bug repellent. Everything else is provided. Adults may bring a chair and a small tarp for the boys to sit on. **No open-toed shoes or sandals are allowed at camp.**

INSURANCE

A special accident insurance policy will be provided. This is secondary insurance and will become effective after a family policy is exhausted.

WHAT ABOUT YOUNGER CHILDREN?

A special area called the Lil' Buddy Camp is available for younger children of adults who are serving as Den Walkers and Staff members. Parents must be at Camp for their child to attend. A nominal fee of \$25 covers the entire week or for any combination of days. Snacks, T-Shirt, and activities will be provided. **Children must be potty-trained.** These children should also bring a sack lunch. You are required to pre-register your Lil' Buddy.

NEED HELP?

A limited number of camperships are available for those who may need help with the fee. The youth's parents must submit the application for a campership by April 30th. Visit our web site www.lhcbasa.org for the campership form or Contact the Scout office at (502) 361-2624 for more information.
