

Eagle Scout Candidates:

You finished your Eagle Scout project and completed your Eagle Scout Rank Application with signatures up to the line **BSA Local Council Verification:**

Now What?

Bring your original Eagle Scout Rank Application to the front desk and ask for a Verified Application.

The Verified Application is simply the Council's version of making sure all dates for merit badges and ranks are correct and completed. You do not need to do anything with the Verified Application except to take it to your Eagle Board of Review. This is just part of the Eagle Scout paperwork.

Now you are ready for the Eagle Scout Board of Review.

Below is the required Eagle paperwork to be turned into Council after the Eagle Board of Review:

- The original Eagle Scout Rank Application with all signatures – Copies of this application will not be accepted.
- The Verified Application – Signatures are not needed on this paperwork.
- Your statement of ambitions, life purpose and leadership positions (Found on the second page of the Eagle Scout Rank Application below Requirement 6)
- The advancement form from the Troop -- Signatures, Name, Date and Rank of Eagle Scout

Once we have received this paperwork, we can certify the paperwork and an Eagle certificate is generated from National. It takes a few weeks to receive a certificate, but an email will be sent to your Scoutmaster when the Eagle certificate is ready for pick up!
