

## EXPLORING BARRIERS TO ABUSE

1. Two-deep leadership.
2. One-on-one contact between adults and youth members is prohibited.
3. Separate accommodations for adults/youth and males/females are required.
4. Male and female leaders required on co-ed activities.
5. Privacy of youth is respected.
6. No hazing, initiation, or secret organizations.
7. Youth leadership is monitored by adult leaders. No corporal punishment.
8. Appropriate attire for all activities.
9. Proper training, equipment, and safety procedures required.
10. No fraternization
11. Awareness of social relationships.
