

Cub Scout Summer Experience

Great Meadows District – July 9 – 11, 2021

Calling all Cub Scouts!

Travel back in time with a great time at camp! Activities each day will revolve around various periods in time, from the Stone Age, Ancient Greece and Medieval times. In addition to fun themed crafts and STEM projects, Scouts will have the classic popular activities of BB guns, archery, fishing, woodworking, etc. Scouts will also create their own time capsule!

- Camp Hours:** Camp begins at 8:30 am and closes at approximately 4:30pm. Please arrive a little early on Friday to finish the one-time check-in details if you were not able to make the pre-camp meeting which is on Thursday July 8 from 4-6pm.
- Camp Location:** Jeffers Bend Environmental Center, 1170 Metcalfe Lane, Hopkinsville, KY 42240 (Note: The road from the main road will curve around a cemetery, please continue to the end.)
- Phone:** Please call Natasha at (270) 839-4165 should you be late, or Scout is not coming to camp.
- Uniform:** All campers will receive a Camp T-shirt. This will be the uniform for camp. Please wear it every day.
- Lunch:** Due to COVID restrictions, we will not be serving food. Please provide a non-perishable lunch each day.
- Shoes:** Closed toe shoes and socks must be worn at camp. **NO SANDALS.**
- Little Buddies:** Little Buddies will eat with their parents. The cost for the child is \$25.00. The parent *must* be present on site for the child to be accepted. Children *must* be potty trained. We will provide activities for them while our Little Buddies Director watches them through their stay at camp.
- Outer-wear:** Hats are helpful to keep the sun off your face and to aid against ticks (check children daily). SUNSCREEN will be helpful to avoid sunburn (note that the Scout with supervision from the Den Walker will have to put their own sunscreen on. Please be sure to put sunscreen on everyday even if it looks cloudy. BUG SPRAY is always good to bring with you to camp (no aerosol cans).

Rain: **CAMP IS OPEN RAIN OR SHINE.** Rain gear will be necessary on rainy days. As long as it is not thunder and lightning, we will continue with camp in the rain. We do have a severe weather plan at our day camp location. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

Transportation: Everyone must provide their own transportation. Carpooling is encouraged. The Guide to Safe Scouting states that beds of trucks, trailers, and campers will not be used to transport passengers at any time, and a seatbelt is required for each passenger in all motor vehicles (except commercial buses). Please be aware of your speed and children.

FISHING: We have a nice fishing spot. We will have fishing with agreeable days and to fulfill our requirements of the Cubs.

MEDICATION: The camp requires that all prescription and over-the-counter (OTC) medications be stored under lock (including those requiring refrigeration), except when in the controlled presence of health care staff responsible for administering and/or dispensing medications. Exceptions will be made for life saving medications i.e. epi pins, inhalers etc.

TRADING POST: There will be a trading post available each day. A list of available items and cost will be provided before camp. No knives are allowed at camp. If you purchase a knife or bring one from home, it will be given to the Den Leader until the close of camp that day.

CLOSING: On Sunday, we plan to begin our den skits, and closing ceremony for our scouts. We welcome all parents or adult partners to attend this with us at 4pm!
