## **LEVEL II ARCHERY INSTRUCTOR CLASS:**

Date: Friday and Saturday, November 6 and 7, 8:00 – 5:00 both days  
(Student will not need to attend on November 6 if they have already completed the Level I certification)

Cost: \$150.00 (The cost is \$75.00 if student has already Completed the Level I certification)

1. Become a member of USA Archery - \$60 per year
2. Complete Safe Sport Training through USA Archery (There is no Charge and this can be done through USA Archery Website)
3. Complete a Background Check through USA Archery (Cost is \$25 and is good for two years)

### **Prepares you for the following:**

1. Train Level I Instructors
2. Train Archery Rangemasters
3. Qualifies you to complete all the tasks that a Level I Instructor can do
