



**SHOOT-A-PALOOZA GENERAL INFORMATION – 2025**  
**FRAZIER SCOUT RESERVATION(CCC)**  
**September 6, 2025**

Welcome to the Council-wide Shoot-A-Palooza. This activity is sponsored by and being organized by the Council Range and Target Activities Committee. We hope that you will have an enjoyable day and help us evaluate how we can improve this event for the future. We have limited the day's activities to approximately 150 shooters in order to keep wait times as short as possible. The information listed below should assist you as you go through the day's activities.

**SAFETY** is going to be the key to having a good day at the event. We encourage all shooters to follow closely the instructions that are given to you by the Instructors and Range Safety Officers on each event. No matter what type of firearm you are using during the day, remember the **THREE Rules of Safe Gun Handling: (1) ALWAYS keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction, (2) ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire and (3) ALWAYS Keep your firearm unloaded until ready to shoot the activity.**

**NOTE: BE SURE TO BRING ALL SCOUTING AMERICA MEDICAL FORMS PARTS A&B WITH YOU. THERE SHOULD BE ONE FOR EACH SHOOTER. (These will need to be presented at packet pickup)**

**COST OF THE EVENT:** The cost of the event is: \$35 for Shooters and \$15 for Non-Shooters. This cost covers lunch, patch, and ammo for the shooters.

**CAMPING:** Camping is available for those units who wish to camp for the weekend. Each unit will need to schedule their own camping through Tentaroo.

Lunch will be provided for all participants in the Dining Hall.

**3:30 EVENT CONCLUDES**

Groups will drive to the Camporee area. **(Just a reminder that parking is limited and you may need to park in the Leadership Development Center Parking Lot across the road from the Camporee Area. Please carpool as much as possible.)**

## SHOOTING ACTIVITIES:

**MAIN CAMP:** Rifle Shooting (Rifle Range)  
Archery (Archery Range)  
Wrist Rockets (Site 5 by the Nature Lodge)  
Cowboy Action Shooting (Shotgun Range)

**CAMPOREE AREA:** Sporting Clays (Begin at Program Shelter)  
Paint Ball (Near Flag Poles on Activity Field)  
Pellet Guns (Activity Field by Entrance)  
Tomahawk Throwing (Activity Field)

## MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- All Shooters should plan to bring a water bottle with them for the day's activities. Firearms will be provided. **Shooters are not to bring their own firearms or ammunition.**
- Groups will be formed with approximately 20 participants. They need to follow the schedule for the events closely (with their group) to keep the wait times at the events to a minimum.
- Event Schedule Time on Location:
  - Main Camp events (Approx. 35 minutes per event)
  - Camporee Area Events
    - 1 hour and 10 minutes for Shotgun (3 stations)
    - 25 minutes each for Paint Ball, Pellet Guns and Tomahawks
