Dear Scouts & Parents,

We have a Prehistorically FUN weekend planned for you. Here is some important information that will help you and your parents have a great weekend at camp. Activities at each day camp are developed around a theme. This year's camp theme is Dinosaurs!! This theme will provide fun and engaging program elements for young boys and girls. Popular activities include BB guns, archery, crafts, sports and water activities.

Camp Hours: Please arrive at Pavilion #1 between 7:30-7:45am on Friday to finish the one-time check-in details. Camp begins promptly at 8:00am with opening flags and closes at approximately 5:15pm. **All Scouts must be picked up by 5:30 pm.**

Uniform: All campers will receive a Camp T-shirt at Friday check-in. This will be the uniform of the week. **Please wear it every day.**

Items to Bring: Hat, change of clothes, swimwear, towel, backpack. Label ALL items with Scout's name. If possible, please pack a second set of clothing for Scouts in the event their clothes get wet. We have activities planned where Scouts may get wet without changing into swimwear in advance. Apply sunscreen and insect repellent before arriving. Do not bring pocket knives or electronic devices.

HEALTH FORM: Everyone attending camp each day will need a BSA Health Form (A&B, both sides). *This includes Adult Partners for Tigers, Youth Staff, and any additional adults associated with Day Camp.* Please

complete and print prior to camp. Our Health Officer will review any concerns with you at registration.

Check In/
Check Out:

Each morning and afternoon all Scouts are to be signed in and out with their Camp Den Walkers. There will be posted signs on the lawn east of Pavillion 1 with your Scouts's Fall '26 rank to help know which Den Walker to check with. If an adult is staying on premise, they will need to be signed in as well.

Lunch:

We are not providing lunch to campers or adults. Please pack your Scouts with lunches each day. We will have no refrigeration available, so please plan accordingly. We will provide campers with several snacks and water throughout the day.

Shoes:

Closed toe shoes and socks must be worn at camp. **NO SANDALS.**

Little Buddies:

Little Buddies will eat and participate with their parents. The cost for the child is \$25.00 for the week. This fee includes a shirt, patch meals, snacks and program supplies. Little Buddies must be potty trained. The parent *must* be present on site.

Outer-wear:

Hats are helpful to keep the sun off your face and to aid against ticks (check children daily). Sunscreen will be helpful to avoid sunburn. Bug repellent is always good to bring with you to camp (no aerosol cans).

Rain:

CAMP IS OPEN RAIN OR SHINE. Rain gear will be necessary on rainy days. We do have a severe weather plan at our day camp location. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

Transportation:

Everyone must provide their own transportation. Carpooling is encouraged. The Guide to Safe Scouting states that beds of trucks, trailers, and campers will not be used to transport passengers at any time, and a seatbelt is required for each passenger in all motor vehicles (except commercial buses). Please be aware of the speed limits posted.

Swimming or
Water Day:

Scouts will be swimming each day at the Oldham County Aquatic Center in the afternoon. Additionally, one day, we will have the LaGrange Fire Department visiting to spray for the Scouts to run

through (please keep this a surprise for the Scouts). Scouts will need a swimsuit and towel each day.

Fishing: We will have a fishing program each day. All Scouts will have the opportunity to fish. Poles and bait will be provided.

Medication: The camp requires that all prescription and over-the-counter (OTC) medications be stored under lock (including those requiring refrigeration), except when in the controlled presence of health care staff or other adult leader responsible for administering and/or dispensing medications. Exceptions will be made for life saving medications i.e. epi pens, inhalers etc.

Trading Post: There will be a trading post available each day.. No knives are allowed at camp. If you purchase a knife or bring one from home, it will be given to the Den Leader until the close of camp that day. New this year for the Trading Post we will be using a 'pre-paid' card so that your Scout will not have to keep track of money throughout the day/week. \$5 punch cards with 25cent or 50cent increments can be bought with cash up front and Scouts will be able to track how much they have left.

Closing: Our Camp will close each day with a closing flag ceremony at 5:00pm each afternoon.

Adult Supervision: As a reminder, Tigers (rising 1st graders) cannot attend Cub Scout events without a parent or guardian present. Rising Lions (incoming Kindergardeners) are not official participants in camp and are considered Little Buddies.
