

American Red Cross Wilderness and Remote First Aid Course:

Scouts and scout leaders, outdoor enthusiasts and anyone who works or spends time in remote environments, this course teaches advanced skills to be used in emergencies when help from professional first responders may be far away. Based on the Boy Scouts of America Wilderness First Aid Curriculum and Doctrine Guidelines. Meets BSA High Adventure Base requirements.

Prerequisites:

Must be at least 14 years old and hold current adult CPR/AED certification (class available below) from one of the following programs: American Red Cross, Canadian Red Cross, Medic First Aid, American Heart Association, National Safety Council, American Safety and Health Institute or Emergency Care and Safety Institute.

Primary and Secondary Assessments	Head/Brain, Neck and Spinal Injuries	Wounds and Wound Infections
Allergies and Anaphylaxis	Bone and Joint Injuries	Heat-Related Emergencies
Altitude-Related Illnesses	Hypothermia	Burns
